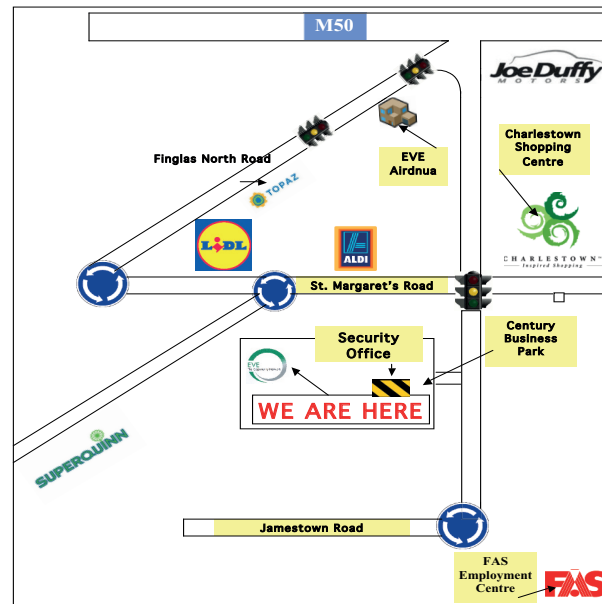

### Location

Castleview is located off St. Margaret's road, Finglas, within Century Business Park. Travelling from Finglas village the local landmarks are; LIDL at McKee Avenue roundabout, further up St. Margaret's Road is ALDI and further again is a crossroads with Charlestown shopping centre on your left. Turn right at the crossroads and take an immediate right into Century Business Park. Introduce yourself to the security staff and ask for directions to Unit 1a. Alternatively, continue to the T junction. Take a right at the T junction and go to the end of the road. The Training Centre is on the corner of the block of units. The main entrance door is at the back of the building, facing onto St. Margaret's Road.
