

## Introduction

EVE has played a leading role in providing high-quality mental health services in communities across Leinster since 1991 and became part of the HSE in 2010. Our services support social inclusion for adults with mental health challenges, autism and intellectual disability. We do this through our network of community-based Clubhouses, HUBs and Vocational Training services across Dublin, Kildare and Wicklow.

Our HUBs aim to be person-led, partnering with each individual to explore their goals and supporting them to live the life of their choosing. Clubhouses are member-led and offer activities focused around work units as well as employment, education and social programmes (in line with the **International Clubhouse Standards**). EVE's Vocational Training programmes offer a range of QQI courses on behalf of **ETBs**, as well as other activities that support students' physical and mental health journeys. HSE Print also hosts a number of EVE members and participants in work experience roles, as part of their Stepping Stones Programme.

### We use a 'Universal Design Approach'...

- treating people as individuals on a unique journey and supporting them in their recovery
- championing people for their strengths and recognising the ways that trauma may have impacted their lives
- being compassionate, respectful and working in partnership with people

### ... And an ongoing commitment to Engagement

We recognise that effective **engagement** is key. We are developing structures to ensure that the lived experience of those who use our services is front and centre, whether they are living with mental health difficulties, intellectual disability, or autism. We value everyone's perspective and will work in partnership with members, participants and their supporters, as well as staff, to develop our culture and improve our services.
